# <u>Ideas discussed included possibly having a space at the Benton County Public Library in</u> downtown Corvallis.

<u>Issues & comments</u>: How permanent would this arrangement be? Would more volunteers be needed to cover more hours, would the number of people using our genealogical materials increase and possibly increase our membership? Would we have a designated room for meetings and programs separate from other areas of the library? Would parking downtown be an issue? Speakers cannot be paid at the public library.

Another idea was possibly having space at the Benton County Historical Museum. Many of the same questions would apply about permanency, needing more volunteers, and a room of our own to hold meetings and possibly programs. The convenience of parking, museum resources and a short distance to walk between our current library in the Annex and the meeting/program space in the church social hall was mentioned.
